- 2. Introduction
 - a. Background information (*Maximum score* 5 %)
 - b. Problem statement (Maximum score 5 %)
 - c. Rationale (*Maximum score 5 %*)
 - d. Research questions/Objectives (Maximum score 5%)
- 3. Literature review (Maximum score 15 %)
- 4. Research Methodology/Materials and methods (*Maximum score 15%*)
- 5. Research results (*Maximum score 15 %*)
- 6. Discussion (Maximum score 5 %)
- 7. Conclusion and recommendations
 - a. Conclusion (Maximum score 5 %)
 - b. Recommendations (Maximum score 5 %)

- 8. Originality of contribution (*Maximum score* 5 %)
- 9. Literature citation (*Maximum score* 5 %)
- 10. Overall Presentation of Dissertation/Thesis (*Maximum score 5 %*)
- 2.1 Both the Internal and External Examiners are required to provide any additional details to be addressed by the student
- 2.2 Both the Internal and External Examiners should give raw marks and a definite recommendation on whether or not the degree should be awarded by filling in a summary recommendation form (PGS 006)
